Enrolment fees

Application Fee: \$330.00 (incl GST) **Acceptance Fee:** \$1,100.00 (incl GST) **Entry Fee:** \$2,000.00 (incl GST)

All enrolment fees are non-refundable and are not credited towards tuition fees. The Application Fee is to be sent with the Application for Enrolment. The Acceptance Fee is payable when the offer of a provisional place is accepted. The Entry Fee is payable after the student has been interviewed and the place is confirmed.

* Fees are the same for all Year Levels and are in addition to tuition fees. Fees include GST charged on the food component.

All fees above are in Australian dollars (AUD). Accounts will be rendered prior to the commencement of each of Terms 1, 2 and 3 for one-third of the annual tuition fee. Ancillary charges may be charged to meet other direct costs (eg. faculty materials supplied to students) and for Co-curricular activities. These are included in Term 2 and Term 3 invoices together with tuition fees, and two further invoices are then issued for ancillary charges in October and December. An Administration Fee will also be applied to overdue accounts to mitigate the cost of recovery.

Methods of payment of tuition fees

The College accepts the payment of fees by one of the following options:

- Payment on invoice in full, due within 30 days by BPAY or credit card. Tuition, Boarding and ancillary charges are invoiced as noted above. Payments should be made on the payments section of the College website using your Family Reference Number and BPAY reference, where applicable. You do not need to logon to the website to make payments.
- Payment of tuition fees in advance. Further information including terms and conditions, and application forms, where required, are available [here](#).
- A fortnightly or monthly direct-debit payment plan is available in equal instalments over ten months or 20 fortnights from February to November. A further final payment is due on 30 November for all remaining outstanding amounts on your Family Account at the conclusion of the plan. Withdrawal or transfer of a student

The withdrawal of a student requires at least one, full school term's notice in writing to the Principal, otherwise 25 per cent of the annual tuition fee in lieu of notice will be payable. As part of the Board of Studies' requirements, it is now compulsory to advise the College, in the notice of withdrawal, the name of the school to which the student is being transferred. The transfer of a student from Boarding to Day Girl status requires one, full school term's notice in writing to the Principal.
