The selection process will be by written application, the scholarship examination and panel interview.

The written application will include:

- A 300 to 500 word autobiographical essay indicating their special interests, achievements as outlined in the criteria, and the contribution they would make to the life of the College. *(To be submitted as part of the online registration process).*
- Two reference letters supporting the candidate's chosen activities.
- The applicant's most recent school report and NAPLAN test results.

The panel interview will include members of the Scholarship Selection Committee and members of staff with responsibility for the candidate's nominated disciplines.

DECLARATION

I understand that if I am selected as one of the recipients of an All-rounder Scholarship at Pymble Ladies' College, the scholarship is conditional on the following:

- 1 A scholarship holder will endeavour to maintain an appropriate level of academic achievement.
- 2 In all areas of school life, a scholarship holder must be a positive role model and fully support the ethos and values of the College.
- 3 A scholarship holder will be expected to represent the school in her relevant sport and co-curricular activities.
- 4 A scholarship holder's performance will be reviewed annually in terms of her participation in College sport and her all-round performance in both co-curricular and academic studies.
